RE: Reminder for submission of Players' Undertaking form

On 26 November 2019, the BWF sent out a Memorandum regarding the Players' Undertaking.

As a reminder, the Player's Undertaking is a document through which players confirm their understanding of BWF rules related to badminton integrity, commercial and media rights, as well as data privacy. It is mandatory for all players ranked 100 and above to sign.

Member Associations were asked to help get these signatures from players under their jurisdiction. The deadline for players to sign the undertaking was set as 31 January 2020.

As of now, approximately 75% of all players have signed the Players' Undertaking. However, we have yet to hear back from several Member Associations and players.

With this reminder, we would ask you to ensure that all the players under your jurisdiction which are ranked 100 as of week 47 2019 and above have personally signed the Players' Undertaking.

It is also important that players provide their personal email address (i.e. not the Member Association's email). Their personal address will be used so that players can be directly informed of critical information, such as integrity cases, but also about important announcements related to tournaments and regulations. The relevant Member Association will also be included in copy in each of the BWF's communications to players' personal email addresses.

Please therefore ensure that the personal email address of each player is updated if this is not already done.

"If you don't complete, you can't compete" - Regulation 4.12 of the General Competition Regulations makes it a requirement for these players to sign the undertaking in order to retain their status as a Registered Player for Entry.

The extended deadline to submit all remaining signed Players' Undertaking is 30 September 2020.

Should you be unable to secure the signature of all top ranked players under your jurisdiction, we would kindly ask you to get in touch with us and explain the reasons for this.
